Pre-registration

Every year we offer our currently enrolled students the opportunity to preregister, thereby avoiding the annual \$35.00 registration fee per student and allowing our current students priority for classes and teachers. Remember, class space is limited. Pre-registration will only last until **June 1**, so act now. While there is no registration fee, pre-registration requires a \$35.00 costume deposit per class which is fully refundable through September. Acrobatic and Company students must also include a \$45.00 liability insurance surcharge at the time of pre-registration.

Summer Classes

University Performing Arts Centre will offer a variety of summer classes. A 5-week summer session will begin on June 9 and end on July 9. Classes meet twice a week and provide the student with an accelerated dance curriculum. Tuition is \$130.00 for 45 minute and 1-hour classes; \$110.00 for 2nd class in family; \$90.00 for 3rd class in family. Tuition is based on 8 lessons; however, 10 lessons are conducted. A dance study program is available for intermediate and advanced students at a cost of \$200.00. Pointe classes are \$65.00 extra. The dance study program encompasses lyrical, tap, ballet, jazz, and musical theater. Two intensive workshops intended for company members (by audition only) are available for \$300.00 for both workshops.

One Week Summer Princess Dance Experience

A fun program has been created for students ages 3 through 6 desiring to broaden their performing skills. The program encompasses tap, ballet, jazz, song & dance, tumbling, modeling, arts and crafts with a performance at the end of the week, on June 5, June 12, July 24 and July 31 at 12:00 PM there will be performance to show off everything they have learned. Classes meet from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM, with a break for snack. \$150 per student 1 camp; \$275 per student for 2 camps; \$375 per student for 3 camps; \$450 per student for all 4 camps.

One Week Summer Dance Experience

A fun program has been created for students ages 6 and over desiring to broaden their performing skills. The program encompasses tap, ballet, jazz, lyrical, hip-hop, choreography, acrobatics, cheerleading/dance team, acting, and arts and crafts with a performance at the end of the week. Classes meet Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, with a one-hour break for lunch/snack. Two sessions will be conducted. The first session meets June 1 - 5; second session meets July 20 - 24; \$300.00 per person for 1 camp; \$550.00 per person for both camps.
